

TRADITIONAL CAMP

YMCA Camp Echo Rock is a child-centered, outdoor adventure program unlike anything else in the area. We use exciting activities to help children make friends, learn skills, gain confidence and make magical summer memories. Campers will have time for archery, ropes challenge course, swimming, boating, arts & crafts, sports & games and outdoor living skills such as fire building, outdoor cooking and camping. Our well trained professional role models create a culture where children feel supported, encouraged and valued.

SCOUTS (entering grades 2-3) – Campers begin their journey into an outdoor-based summer camp while developing vital, lifelong skills. Scouts learn the value of teamwork, honesty, respect, and responsibility as they enjoy activities such as archery, boating, climbing wall, and outdoor living.

NAVIGATORS (entering grades 4-5) – Campers dive deeper into the realm of outdoor living with plenty of adventure! Campers learn skills including camp cooking and knot tying, while still enjoying all of their summer camp favorites. Programing is more thought provoking and will challenge your camper grow both physically and mentally. More advanced climbing, camping and boating skills are emphasized.

PATHFINDERS (entering grades 6-8) – This program challenges campers to go beyond their comfort zone and is designed to empower them to take chances and develop a stronger sense of self-worth. We promote leadership and independence with a group-influenced schedule while staying true to our outdoor living roots. Campers learn to master and practice advanced outdoor living skills.

CIT (Counselor-In-Training ages 14-16) – This three week program is designed to bring out leadership skills and develop strong self-confidence. CITs learn what it takes to be a leader in an outdoor living-based camp. We are looking for campers who have a reasonable understanding of outdoor living skills and aren't afraid to get dirty. CITs assist in leading activities as well as developing and teaching new activities to campers all under the watchful eye of a counselor.



IMPORTANT INFORMATION REGISTRATION

Complete the registration form entirely, one per camper and return it to the Valley Shore YMCA. A \$50 non refundable deposit per session is due upon registration. The preferred method of payment is to enroll in our Automatic Credit Card Charge Option. Payment is due 2 full weeks prior to the start of your child's camp. Each child must have a completed health form on file at least two weeks prior to the start of camp. You can drop off, mail or fax your registration form.

SCHEDULE

Camp Echo Rock offers one-week sessions from June 25 to August 17. Regular camp hours are 9 a.m. to 4 p.m. Extended care is available at Valley Shore YMCA, 7 a.m. to 6 p.m.
