Half day, M-F sailing lessons begin every week from June 25th to August 24th. Beginner through advanced lessons are available. *Learn more about our **NEW** lesson levels below:*

Sailing 1 (S1): this is the place to start! Young sailors learn safety, confidence, and good boating habits on the water. Kids learn on 9' Laser Bugs and 13' Sunfish for older students.

Prerequisites: students must be at least 8 years old or have completed 2nd grade, plus have the ability to swim. Repeating this class is highly recommended for younger students.

Sailing 2 (S2): move on to the second step in our curriculum! Students move from a single sailed boat to a sloop-rigged double-handed dinghy. This class uses 14' RS Quests.

Prerequisites: students must have taken S1, and be at least 9 years old or have completed 3rd grade.

Sailing 3 (S3): this course offers an exciting step up in performance to agile, sporty 13' Flying Juniors (FJs)! In double-handed sailing drills, students learn all about their boats and how to work together as a team.

Prerequisites: students must have taken S2 twice, and be at least 11 years old or have completed 5th grade.

Sailing 4 (S4): Our most challenging course is a ton of fun for students seriously interested in fine-tuning their sailing skills! This is a high-energy class that will prepare students to race on the new Morgan Sailing team.

Prerequisites: students must have taken S3 twice, and be at least 13 years old or have completed 7th grade. This course may be repeated multiple times for continued skill development.
